The forum will last two days, 14 and 15 October.

Astana is hosting the Fourth Conference of Ministers of Justice of the Central Asian countries and the European Union, Kazpravda.kz reports.

The conference is attended by representatives of 13 delegations of the Ministries of Justice of the EU and Central Asia, representatives of international and non-governmental organizations, the Kazakh government agencies and organizations, businessmen, MPs.

The agenda includes such topical issues as constitutional law, criminal law and procedure, development and independence of the judiciary. Besides, the delegates will consider the measures taken by the countries of Central Asia and the European Union to ensure the initiative of the EU rule of law for Central Asia.

In the frames of the initiative, the EU assists the Central Asian countries in fulfillment of the key legal reforms in the justice sector, development of effective legislation and potential of the executive judiciary.

The Rule of Law Initiative was launched at the first Ministerial Conference of the European Union and Central Asia in Brussels in November 2008.
