Regional Seminar **"Life in the state of law - ensuring equal rights and opportunities of women"** will be held on 14-15 November 2014 in the framework of the rule of law initiative for Central Asia, is being organised by the Rule of Law Platform – Central Asia, financed by the European Union, with the assistance of NGO "League of Women lawyers RT", and expertise from the European Union of Women. The event will be attended by representatives of Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan. It is placed under the high patronage of the President of the Republic of Tajikistan.

The main purpose of the event is to discuss best international practices aiming at protecting the rights of women against domestic violence, the discussion of issues related to family and economic arrangements that association, the improvement of women's capacities, the right to education and training, as well as the prospects for the creation of the Association of Women in Central Asia.

The upcoming workshop at the regional level to promote equality of rights and opportunities for women aimed at deepening the dialogue and exchange of best practices on the protection of women's rights. Workshop participants develop and adopt the recommendations in these areas.

As participants of the regional seminar invited 50 representatives from government, civil society and international organizations from a number of countries in Central Asia and Europe, court presidents of Tajikistan, the General Prosecutor's Office of Tajikistan, representatives of embassies, international organizations and NGOs of the Republic of Tajikistan.
