A regional conference on cooperation of judicial and legal training institutions will be held in Bishkek

A regional conference on “Networks of Judicial and Legal Training Institutions: Factor for the Success of Judicial Reform” will take place with support from the European Union-funded projects “Promotion of the Rule of Law in the Kyrgyz Republic” and “EU-Central Asia Rule of Law Platform” on June 22-23, 2016 in “Damas” hotel, Bishkek city.

This event will be organized in order to strengthen international cooperation of institutions in charge of providing training to legal professions, and to share advanced European experience in the field of training and further education.

The conference will be attended by deputies of Zhogorku Kenesh, representatives of Supreme Court, Constitutional Chamber, Council for the selection of judges, Council of judges, General Prosecutor Office, Training Centers for Judges, Prosecution Officers and lawyers, the Central Asian League of Lawyers, representatives of the French and German Embassies in Kyrgyzstan, the European Union delegation in Kyrgyzstan, as well as experts and representatives of training centers of France, Germany, Bulgaria, Poland, Russia, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Kazakhstan.

During the two-day conference, the relevant problems of judicial and training organizations in Central Asia will be considered, models of judicial and legal trainings will be discussed and the best training practices will be presented. The participants will get more information on the trends and technologies of further training of lawyers in Europe and in Central Asian countries and will discuss the possibilities to strengthen the regional cooperation in this field, including the establishment of the regional network.

Project “Promotion of the Rule of Law in the Kyrgyz Republic” is funded by the European Union and is implemented by a Consortium of six European organizations under the leadership of the German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ). This Project expresses full commitment to support joint efforts of the partners of Kyrgyz Republic in the field of promoting the rule of law in the country.
